

Ephesians 5 is often our "go-to" passage for teaching on the family. But, before chapter 5, there are some foundational principles that make chapter five and beyond work. The first "fundamental" to a great home team is found in chapter 1.

### I. Become a \_\_\_\_\_ (Ephesians 1:1)

God's plan to change my home is to change \_\_\_\_\_, not my circumstances, finances, spouse or kids. The first and most important change is salvation--the act of becoming a "saint".

- Paul calls Christians "saints" 9 times in Ephesians, from the Greek word, hagios (holy ones).
- The S\_\_\_\_ of God is called "the holy one" [hagios] four times in the New Testament. (Acts 3:14)
- The S\_\_\_\_\_ of God is called the "Holy [hagios] Spirit" or "Holy Ghost" 96 times. (1:13)
- The \_\_\_\_\_ is called, "Holy, holy, holy!" and, "the holy One". (Isaiah 1:4; 6:1-3; 57:15)

When I am born into this Holy Family, I take on their identity and character. (cp. 1 Corin. 6:9-11)

It's easy to become a saint, but much harder to be a saint. We become a saint in an instant, but we spend the rest of our lives learning how to be one.

- II. \_\_\_\_\_ a saint (Ephesians 1:4 ...that we should be holy.... [hagios])
  - Now that I am a saint (1:1), I am to b\_\_\_\_\_ like a saint (1:4). (cp. Ephesians 5:3; 1 Peter 1:15; 1 Thessalonians 4:3, 7)
    What if others in my home are not saved? -- Be a ""!
- When was I born again into God's family, thus becoming a "saint"?
- In what ways should I behave more "saintly" this week?



#### Fundamental #2 I have the Holy Spirit in me, now I must choose to let Him fill me, and control me.

### What I must KNOW to be filled with God's Spirit?

- A. Being Spirit-filled is not an emotion, but a c\_\_\_\_\_ (Acts 6:3-5)
- B. I \_\_\_\_\_ be changed (Philippians 4:13; Romans 6)
- **C. I MUST be filled** (Eph. 3:20 -- Without God's power working in me, I am helpless to change.)
  - You might as well try to see without eyes, hear without ears, or breathe without lungs, as to try to live the Christian life without the Holy Spirit." - D. L. Moody

### II. What must I DO to be filled with God's Spirit?

- A. Ask for the filling of the Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13; James 4:2; Eph. 6:10-11)
- B. Make daily spiritual choices that feed and nourish my spiritual nature
  - Eph. 4:22-24 ...put off concerning the former conversation the old man... and put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
  - The main reason I am not filled with the Spirit, is because I am filled with everything else.
  - Small daily choices may be causing me to lose the big battles in my life and my home.
    - My flesh keeps winning because that's what I'm feeding.
    - God wants all of me, and my day, and my week, not just a piece of me.
    - Most of us have moved from poison to popcorn, but a popcorn-only diet will also kill me.
- C. Listen to the Spirit -- Operate under His influence (Eph. 5:18; cp Luke 1:15; Acts 2:1-13)
  "Spirit-filled" in the Bible means "Spirit-c"."

### What HAPPENS with the Holy Spirit is filling (controlling) me?

- A. The f\_\_\_\_\_ of the Spirit will show up in my life and my home. (Eph. 5:9; Gal. 5:15, 22-25)
  - Good fruit is the natural product of a healthy, watered, well-nourished tree.

## B. The power of the Spirit will show up in my w\_\_\_\_\_. (Acts 2, 4)

Fundamental #3 I have received much grace, now give much grace.

- Grasp grace (The word, "grace", occurs \_\_\_\_\_ times in Ephesians. ex. 1:2, 6, 7;) I.
  - Α. Grace understood
    - The undeserved favor, kindness and help from God that empowers me to desire and to • do God's will.
  - **me** (Eph. 1:6-7; 2:5, 8-9 -- When did I receive this grace? Β. Grace to
  - C. Grace to strengthen and to sanctify (purify) me (Eph. 3:7-8; 4:7; 6:24)
    - Grace is used more frequently of our daily walk than of our eternal salvation in the NT.
    - The same divine power of God that saved me, is available every day to strengthen me.
      - **Power to overcome** (Eph. 3:7; Romans 6:14)
        - Grace gives me the super-human ability to do what I cannot do in this flesh.
        - In what area(s) do I need grace this week?
    - 2. **Power to serve** (Eph. 3:8)
    - **Power to rejoice** (2 Corinthians 12:9-10 -- A grace that makes my pain bearable) 3.
  - in grace (2 Peter 3:18) G
  - for grace (Hebrews 4:16; 1 Peter 5:5) Α. Α
    - "Grace to help in time of need" is obtained in the same way I obtained grace for salvation -- acknowledge my need, ask God for grace, and accept His promise by faith in His Word.

Β. **Depend on grace** (2 Cor. 12:7 *My grace is sufficient for thee....* --Grace grows through trials.) III.

- grace (Eph. 4:29-32 ...minister grace... even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.) G
  - Grace is not earned or deserved. It is not a merit system. (i.e. "If you will... I will....")
  - Marriage is a picture of our q -based relationship with Christ. (Romans 5:8)
  - Grace forgives, but authority is given to administer consequences. Those in authority must still " by our words, attitude and tone, even while ministering punishment. "minister a
  - I have access to an infinite supply of God's grace, but I have to give it away to keep getting it.
  - What opportunities might I have this week to give grace?

## Fundamental #4 My sins are forgiven and I'm going to heaven, so \_\_\_ c\_\_\_\_ j\_\_\_\_.

Ephesians 5:18-19

- I. Joy is a c\_\_\_\_\_ (1 Thessalonians 5:16; Psalm 33:1; James 1:2)
  - Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord \_\_\_\_\_, and again I say, Rejoice!
  - Joy is a c\_\_\_\_\_ (Philippians 2:17; Habakkuk 3:17-18; Romans 8:14-18; 28)
    - Philippians is a "Prison Epistle" whose theme is "\_\_\_\_\_" and "rejoicing", found a total of 18 times.
    - In Psalm 34, David is not rejoicing because life is good, but because \_\_\_\_\_ is good.
    - Psalm 118:24 This is the day which the LORD hath made; \_\_\_\_\_ rejoice and be glad in it.
- III. Joy is communicated by spiritual songs (The Psalms; Exodus 15; Judges 5; 1 Sam. 2, 18, etc.)
  - "Spiritual songs" are the natural result of being filled with the Holy Spirit. (Ephesians 5:19)
  - A Spirit-filled Christian is a singing Christian.
  - Wherever the g\_\_\_\_\_ has gone it has always brought joyful singing. (Ps. 40:3 "a new song")

## IV. Joy is created by spiritual songs

- M\_\_\_\_\_ affects my spirit and the mood of my home.
- Spiritual music defeats and drives away my enemies. (2 Chronicles 20:22; 1 Samuel 16:23)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ counterfeits everything God made "good," including music.

#### Fundamental #5 I will show gratitude to the people in my life.

- I. Gratitude commanded (Psalm 95:2; 100:4; 106:1; Col. 3:15-17; 1 Thess. 5:18; Heb. 13:15)
  - Ephesians 5:20 *Giving thanks \_\_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_ things unto God and the Father....*
  - 1 Thess. 5:18 In \_\_\_\_\_ give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus....

#### II. Gratitude examples

Daniel (Dan. 6:10); Jonah (Jon. 2:9); Zerubbabel and returnees from exile (Ezra 3:11); David (Psalm 35:18); One healed leper (Luke 17:11-16); Jesus (John 6:11; Luke 22:19 - for His last meal, which was also a picture of His own death); Paul (Acts 27:35);

- **B.** For p\_\_\_\_\_ in my life (Ephesians 1:16; Romans 1:8; Philemon 4; 1 Thessalonians 1:2) Philippians 1:3 The letter to the Philippians is Paul's "Thank you note" to his supporters.
